EXECUTIVE SUMMARY



On 30 May 2026, Ikoku visited Naguru Children's Remand Home as part of the Iko-Rehab Fundraiser. During the visit, we conducted a practical session on conflict management and emotional regulation with 150 children and delivered essential items purchased through the generosity of our supporters.

We used group discussions, practical exercises, and reflection activities to explore common sources of conflict and discuss positive ways of managing emotions.

Alongside the learning activities, the donated items helped address some of the immediate needs within the remand home.

This report provides an account of the resources contributed, how they were utilized, and the activities carried out during the visit.



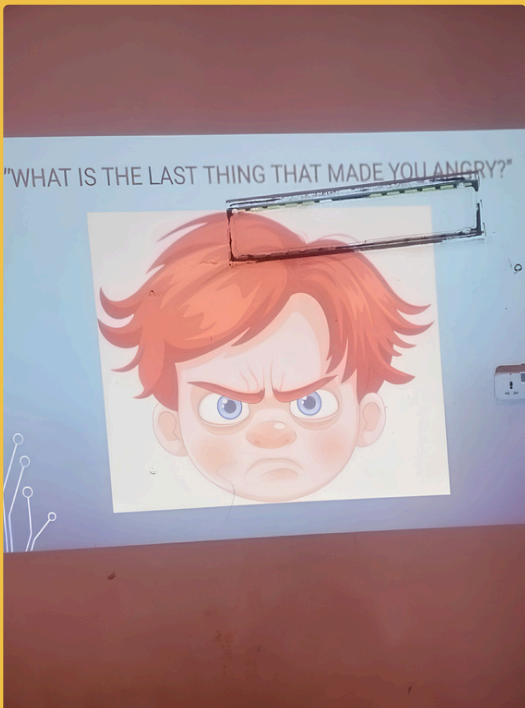
THE OUTREACH ACTIVITY

A team of six volunteers from Ikoku visited Naguru Children's Remand Home to conduct the Iko-Rehab outreach.

The engagement began with a structured session on conflict management and emotional regulation. Children participated in group discussions, role plays, games, question-and-answer exchanges, and practical exercises designed to help them reflect on how they respond to conflict and explore healthier ways of managing emotions.

Following the session, the team distributed essential items to support the daily needs of the remand home. These included hygiene supplies such as sanitary pads, shavers, petroleum jelly, toothpaste, toothbrushes, and laundry soap, as well as sanitation materials including scrubbing brushes and liquid soap. Food items, including sugar and rice, were also provided.

Snacks were also shared with the children to support their wellbeing during long waiting hours in court processes.





FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY

During the Iko-Rehab Fundraiser, a total of UGX 1,300,000 was raised in cash contributions.

These funds were used to support the implementation of the outreach activity at Naguru Children's Remand Home, including the purchase of essential items and snacks for the children.

The remaining balance of **UGX 100,000** will be retained and allocated towards upcoming Iko-Rehab activities supporting children in conflict with the law.

In-Kind Contributions

In addition to cash contributions, in-kind support was received from **Scribbles and Giggles** consisting of teenage colouring books and colouring materials. These materials will be used during structured psychosocial sessions with children with the child psychologists to support emotional expression and engagement.



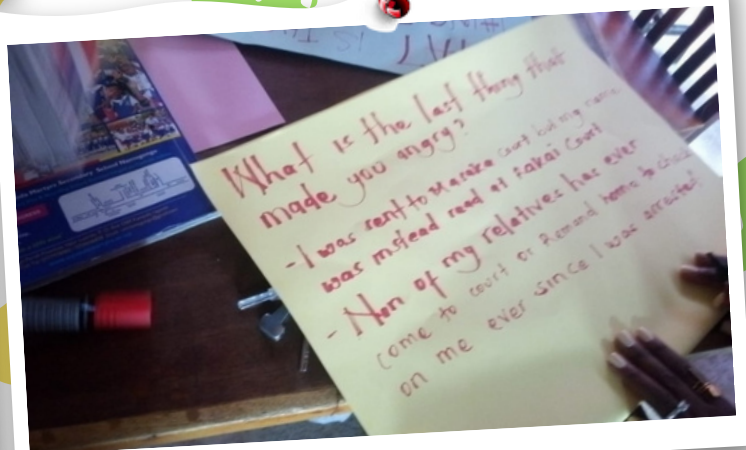
